OPEN DISCUSSION:

1. Traffic Calming Initiatives

With Township growth, more vehicles are using Township roads to avoid the more heavily traveled main roads. The Township is investigating various initiatives to calm traffic on Township roads. Mr. Otteni discussed the recently constructed Sunrise Boulevard islands project. After receiving many resident requests, a speed study was conducted that identified a speeding concern.

As an on-going project, the PSC will assist in developing a policy for traffic calming initiatives that includes types of traffic calming methods, identifies the need for traffic calming, verifies traffic calming is wanted by the majority of the neighborhood, how to implement the initiative, and who pays for the construction and future maintenance. Some calming methods discussed included islands, narrow curb lines, striping i.e. bike lanes, sidewalks, speed tables, and signage.

2. Public Works Department Updates


Mr. Dakin mentioned that the Route 100 Pump Station upgrade project was underway; Glasgow, Inc. was awarded the paving contract with work beginning in the summer; and, based on the recent heavy storms, the Public Works Department is looking at drainage solutions throughout the Township.
