Police Officer Applications

Individuals interested in applying for the position of police officer with the West Whiteland Township Police Department shall submit a completed application to the police department. The police administration office must receive all completed applications no later than Monday, July 29, 2019 at 4:00 PM. Those interested in the position should obtain a copy of the application from the township's website (www.westwhiteland.org) or by picking up an application at the police administration office during normal business hours.

General Qualifications

1. All applicants must be a citizen of the United States of America.
2. All applicants must be physically and mentally fit and able to perform the essential duties of a police officer.
3. All applicants must possess and retain the ability to provide credible testimony in a court of law.
4. All applicants must successfully complete the ACT 120 training in accordance with the Pennsylvania Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC) as well as successfully pass the MPOETC certification test within the last two years prior to appointment or possess a valid MPOETC certification number prior to appointment.
5. All applicants must possess a diploma from an accredited high school or graduate equivalency diploma (GED) prior to appointment.
6. All applicants must have successfully completed at least sixty (60) credits from an accredited university/trade school or thirty (30) credits from an accredited university/trade school along with two years active duty military service prior to appointment.
7. All applicants must possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license issued by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania prior to appointment.
8. Any felony conviction is an automatic disqualification. Any criminal activity that would be considered a felony under Pennsylvania law, federal law, or the law of the state in which the activity occurred is a disqualification.
9. Once hired, applicants must be willing and able to receive oleoresin capsicum (O.C.) spray, as well as temporary exposure to a conductive energy weapon (Taser).
